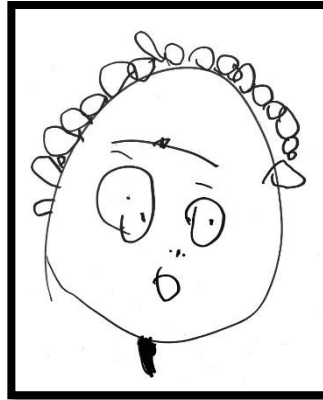

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| <p>Starting Nursery-Learning names, teacher names, greetings, Talk about summer holidays, naming different experiences.</p> <p>To know I have changed since I was a baby, to describe humans at different ages/life stages. We will look at baby photos and how we have changed. We will have a visit from a baby and see how their needs are different to ours.</p> <p>I know how I look after myself and can compare this to how a baby is looked after.
